Europe in the age of multiple challenges. Past and present

The end of the twentieth century was marked by the end of the confrontation between two blocs with antithetical ideologies. The break-up of the Soviet Union and the transition to a new world order made it possible for the member states of the Eastern bloc to choose a European path. Thus, Romania sets a pro-European path, becoming in turn a member state of the Council of Europe, NATO and the EU. Undoubtedly, the culmination of this trajectory was the takeover of the rotating Presidency of

the EU Council in the first part of 2019, when Romania ended its term with a positive balance. However, 2019 was also marked by the continuation of debates over the conditions for Britain's exit from the European family, a process that ended with its withdrawal on 31 January 2020. In addition to Brexit, 2020 brought another major challenge, triggering a global health crisis. COVID 19 surprised the European Union, and implicitly Romania, as well as the whole world. In 2021 new crises are added to the pandemic (war in Ukraine, energy crisis, climate crisis, a new immigrant crisis (on the Belarus-EU nexus), a possible Polesxit, political crises in some EU Member States, etc.), all requiring solutions adapted to the global context for the future sustainable development of the contemporary society.

The 4th edition of the National Scientific Session aims to provide an academic and competitive framework for communicating the results of the most relevant research of students on the history, role and place of Romania in Europe, as well as in the socio-political field and media.

The event will take place between 23 and 24 May 2022 and is addressed to undergraduate, master's or doctoral students in the fields of History, International Relations, European Studies, Political Science, Sociology, Law, Administrative Science, Communication Science, History, etc..

The session program includes 2 panels:



1. The EU in the age of multiple challenges - Role playing - Summit of EU Member States / Heads of Government at the European Council

Simulation game: Crisis in Ukraine: challenges and solutions

2. Europe/EU in the age of multiple challenges. Crises and solutions - Scientific communications session in the fields: history, international relations, European studies, political science, communication sciences, geography

Student papers will be evaluated by a jury (based on criteria that highlight the scientific nature, compliance with academic standards and originality of research conducted by students), and the most relevant research, respectively positions in the simulation of the Summit will be rewarded with prizes. The organizers will also publish the research results in a volume, which will be indexed in international databases.

Schedule

April 1 - May 3, 2022 - receipt of participation proposals (each student will send to the organizing committee a title and an abstract of max. 300 words for communication, or a letter of intent for participation in the role-playing activity)

May 5 - May 6 - selection of participants made by the scientific committee

May 9 - communication of results and distribution of roles for the simulation activity

May 23, 2022 - presentation of communications by sections (bachelor's, master's, doctorate)

May 24, 2022 - role playing and awards ceremony

International students (non-Romanian speaking students at bachelor, master, PhD) level can only participate at the scientific communications session, as the simulation game will be held in Romanian language!!! They are expected to send the title and abstract in English language until the specified date. After the event, it will be provided the deadline and the guide time for the elaboration of the scientific article.

The event will be held via Zoom!
